SCRIP

Greetings!

What is SCRIP? SCRIP turns everyday shopping into cash to reduce your tuition and help JPII Catholic Schools' sustainability. You can use retail gift cards to pay for everyday purchases—from gas to groceries to clothing and meals out—instead of the usual credit/debit cards. For example; if you buy \$200.00 worth of grocery cards a week, you will bank \$5.00 a week for tuition, which equals \$260.00 a year off of tuition and \$260.00 for JPII Catholic Schools. It's a win-win!

How it works:

- JPII Catholic Schools will buy the gift cards at 2%-15% less than face value (varies by retailer).
- Families then buy the gift cards through the SCRIP program at face value and the family percentage of the credit offered by the retailer is applied to your tuition account.
- Encourage grandparents, extended family members, friends and co-workers to purchase cards on your account. The more people you have buying on your account the more tuition dollars you'll save. (This past year we had a family save over \$1700.00 of their tuition!)
- Do you know a future family of the JPII Catholic Schools? They can also participate in SCRIP by banking tuition dollars for five years in advance.
- We offer ScripNow which is an app that allows you to download cards using your smartphone. Families that are using that option absolutely love the convenience it offers.

We encourage all families to participate in SCRIP whether it be for your own family, sponsoring another family, or having the entire tuition credit go back to JPII Catholic Schools.
