

**Sullivan Middle School  
Supply Checklist  
2017-2018**

- You need to have a New American Bible available at home for your student to use. St. Joseph edition is preferred, but any NAB will do.

A **CONSTANT SUPPLY** of the following needs to be available to your student:

- LOW ODOR dry erase markers; needed for math EVERY DAY  
 regular pencils (no mechanical pencils, please)  
 red pens  
 college-ruled loose-leaf paper—NO WIDE-RULED PAPER (please stock up when on sale☺)

**CLASSROOM SUPPLIES**

- 3 large boxes of tissues *give to advisory teacher*
- 8 heavyweight grocery bags *keep in locker until instructed to use*
- 2 highlighters *any colors*
- 1 pack ruled index cards (100) *needed for notecards*
- 1 LARGE glue stick *needed for several classes*
- 1 Texas Instruments TI 30x calculator (please write student name on calculator and cover) *about \$10-12*
- 1 box of at least **24** colored pencils *needed for several classes*
- 1 scissors
- spiral-bound notebooks as follows
- GRADE 6    3 any color PLUS one COMPOSITION style notebook
- GRADE 7    5 any color PLUS one COMPOSITION style notebook
- GRADE 8    5 any color PLUS one COMPOSITION style notebook

**ORGANIZATIONAL TIP:** Your student may benefit by choosing a specific color notebook for each class.

- EITHER** 1 expanding file (minimum of 7 slots) **OR** 1 trapper keeper with 7 folders
- OPTIONAL**
- assorted magnets to use in lockers—**tape is not permitted** on insides or outsides of lockers

It's been suggested that students MAY want to have their own set of headphones or earbuds to be able to listen to assigned videos in the library, especially if they've been absent. The sharing of these items isn't sanitary and they can be purchased for minimal cost. Some stores have earbuds for as little as a dollar; nothing high tech or expensive is necessary.
