As always, if you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact me.

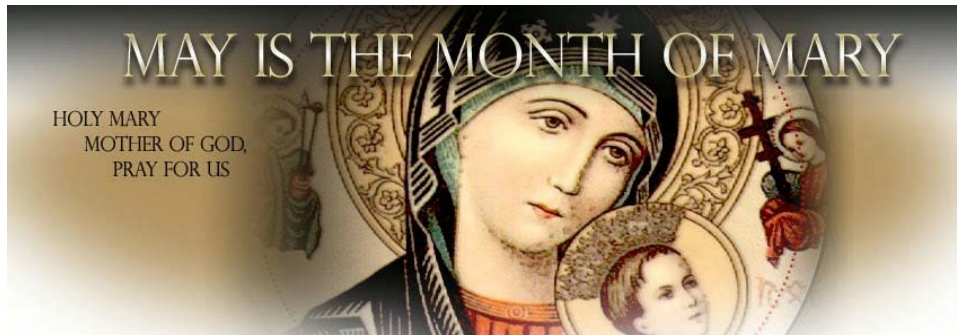
