



ACCEPTABLE USE AGREEMENT **JPII Catholic Schools Policy 2003** **Digital Citizenship** **Elementary Schools**

The use of JPII Catholic Schools' technology, including Internet use, is a privilege, not a right. Inappropriate use may result in cancellation of privileges, as determined by the School Principal. Prior to using the technology services, students, and their parents must understand and accept the conditions of the Acceptable Use Agreement.

The technology services are offered to further educational goals by facilitating resource sharing and promoting innovative global learning opportunities for students. Material viewed, created and/or stored on the technology is not guaranteed to be private and may be reviewed by the school and/or Network Administrators at any time to insure that usage is appropriate, has a legitimate educational purpose, and is in conformance with this agreement.

Acceptable use of the technology includes:

1. I will only use the Internet and computers with the teacher's permission and for the purpose that the teacher has requested.
2. I will respect the school computer equipment, I will not damage, change or tamper with the hardware, software, settings or the network.
3. I will not use any form of electronic communication to harass, frighten or bully anyone.
4. I will only use my own passwords that have been given to me by the teacher.
5. I will not view, send or display inappropriate messages or pictures.
6. I will let my teacher know immediately if I see anything on the Internet that is inappropriate or that makes me feel uncomfortable.
7. I will respect copyright laws and will make sure to show where I found information.
8. I will print only when the teacher says to print.
9. I understand that I will only be able to use the school computers if I follow these rules.
