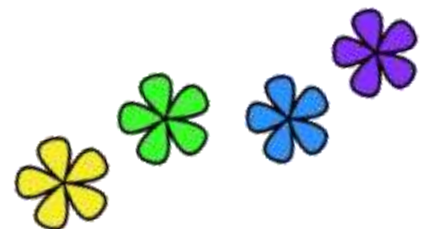
Arts Week, June 17 – 21
