St. John Paul II Catholic Schools Admissions Checklist for Shanley High School

Applicants need to complete the following steps in order to be considered for admission at Shanley High School

- **Application:** Submit an online Application for Shanley High School. A \$100.00 non-refundable application fee must accompany the completed application
- **Teacher, Counselor, or Principal Recommendation:** The **Recommendation Form** should be submitted by the applicant to a teacher, counselor, or principal from the applicant's current school.
- **Official Administrative Record:** The **Release of Records Form** should be submitted by the applicant to the applicant's current school to release transcript/ grades earned from the current and previous school year along with recent standardized test results, behavior and attendance records, and applicable academic or behavioral supports.
- **Transcript:** Submit the most recent copy of student's grades or transcript
- **Interview/Tour:** The Admissions Director will schedule an interview and tour subsequent to the receipt of Official Administrative Records, transcripts and recommendations from the applicant's current school; and prior to acceptance and completion of the online enrollment process.
- **Shadow (Optional):** Spend a half-day at Shanley High School. Shadow opportunities will be available and scheduled by the Admissions Office subsequent to the receipt of transcripts, recommendations from the applicant's current school, and completion of the admissions interview.
- **Notification:** Email and/or letter notification will be sent to applicants for admissions advising of acceptance but only after:
 - 1) The applicant has completed the entire process as described above.
 - 2) The Admissions Team has made a determination concerning the individual's admissions status.

The St. John Paul II Catholic Schools Admissions Team reviews each student's complete application file when rendering a decision. JP II Catholic Schools reserves the right to revoke acceptance at any time for academic and/or disciplinary reasons.
