



JPII Health Screening and Safety Guidelines

- Student and staff symptom check is required before coming to school each day.
- Parents are asked to self-report to the school if their student has symptoms of Covid-19, has tested positive for Covid-19, or has been identified as a close contact within the last 14 days. Staff is asked to self-report in the same manner.
- Students and staff with any symptoms of Covid-19 must stay home and isolate, **THIS IS KEY!!!**

Student or staff with Covid-19 Symptoms: (Daily Symptom Check) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fever ≥ 100.4 • Loss of taste or smell • Cough, nontypical • Chills • Shortness of breath • Headache, nontypical • Muscle aches • Sore throat • Nasal congestion, nontypical • Running nose, nontypical • Diarrhea, Nausea, Vomiting 	Isolate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay home for 10 days from the first onset of symptoms AND at least 24 hours with no fever, without fever-reducing meds AND symptoms have improved. <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Test negative for Covid-19 • Doctor has diagnosed a condition that does not require exclusion. (Note required)
Student or staff test positive for Covid-19	Isolate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you have no symptoms, you can return 10 days after testing positive for Covid-19. • If you develop symptoms: Stay home for 10 days from the first onset of symptoms AND at least 24 hours with no fever, without fever-reducing meds AND symptoms have improved.
Student or staff who have been identified as a close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid-19.	Quarantine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stay home for 14 days after last contact. • If you develop symptoms: Stay home for 10 days from the first onset of symptoms AND at least 24 hrs. with no fever, without fever-reducing meds AND symptoms have improved. • Household contacts quarantine for 14 days after last exposure. Because of ongoing exposure, the 14 days does not start until the positive case is released from isolation.

***YOU CANNOT TEST OUT OF QUARANTINE!**

Additional Information

1. All positive cases and close contact tracing are handled in consultation with assigned Field Epidemiologist.
2. Official notification and contact tracing are conducted by local healthcare agencies.
3. Students or staff presenting symptoms during the day will be isolated in the designated Covid-19 room until transportation home is arranged. **Parents are required to pick up their child within 30 minutes.**
