Modified In-School Learning Update

On September 15th, Mr. Hagstrom announced that JP2I Catholic Schools will shift to Modified In-School Learning starting Monday, September 21st. In accordance with the change, is that visitors will be restricted in all schools to appointment only. This will include a parent dropping off an item for their child or something for the office. FROM THE COUNSELING OFFICE

AP Exam Signup

The sign up is now available in the counseling office for the AP exams in May. The cost is \$95/per test payable to JPII Schools. ND Department of Public Instruction will cover the full exam fee for the student's first qualifying exam (Science, Math, and English exams) and will cover approximately 50% of the exam fees for the next 3 qualifying exams over the student's high school career. For example: students who qualify for one exam fee will only pay the \$9 (school exam fee). An exam at approx. 50% off would pay \$52. If needed, contact Mrs. Anderson to confirm the correct fee payment amount prior to sign up. **The deadline to sign up is Friday, October 30.**

The AP exam schedule is as follows:

AP Calculus AB: Tuesday, May 4 (8am)

AP English Lit: Wednesday, May 5 (8am)

AP US History: Thursday, May 6 (8am)

AP Psychology: Tuesday, May 11 (noon)

Seniors: October is ND College Application Month

College Application Month is part of a national effort to increase the numbers of people applying to college early in the year. Bank of North Dakota (BND) is paying one \$35 application fee per student when they apply to a North Dakota college. College Application Month will take place virtually, October 1-31, through the Career Compass website

<https://www.careercompass.nd.gov/>.

Shanley will not be hosting an “event,” so students can apply any day in October to a ND college or university, with the code **CAM2020** to get ONE \$35 app fee paid for. BND will be monitoring students who use the code multiple times and they should understand that they are responsible for additional application they submit. Please note: NDSU and Concordia’s application is already free for all students. MN State Community & Technical College (MState) is also offering an application fee code (use: CKM2020) for October.

If a student needs support completing an application, please contact Mrs. Anderson in the Counseling office.

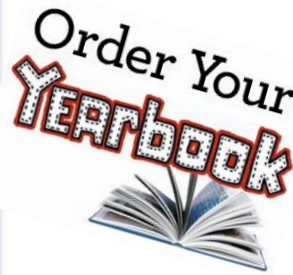
