## EDUCATION IN VIRTUES

Little Deacons to Grade 8

April 26 Virtue of the week: **PRUDENTIAL ACTS**

**Guard It:** The cardinal virtue of prudence aims to perfect our common sense in both practical and moral decisions. It is right reason in action. At our Baptism, our heavenly Father gave us this virtue to aid us in making good decisions. Like any gift, it must be guarded from that which prevents us from cultivating good habit.

**Prudential Acts:** There are three parts in the decision-making process. The virtue of prudence orders and perfects each of the following:

1. **Good Council:** Seeking advice from a reasonable or trustworthy person.
2. **Good Judgement:** Thinking rightly about a decision and carefully considering all the circumstance and asking “What am I to do now?”
3. **Command:** Directly acting upon a sound decision after thoughtful deliberation.
