A majority of the annual back-to-school paperwork is done electronically through ParentsWeb. Access these documents by logging into your ParentsWeb account, go to Web Forms, then Family Demographic Forms, and choose Receipt and Acknowledgement Form. Within this group you will acknowledge that you and your child have read and reviewed the following grade-level specific documents: Student/Parent Handbook, Code of Conduct, Communicating Concerns Protocol, Field Trip Permission, Concussion Information (6-12 grades only), Acknowledgement and Risk Warning (grades 4 & 5 or 6-12 only), and Release of Medical Information (HIPAA) (6-12 grades only).

Both electronic signatures are required to complete the process and must be done for each student before the start of school or first activities practice. All documents are linked to the specific grade groups and are also posted on the JP2 website under Student Resources for future reference.
